### If you are seeing repeat situations such as those listed below, you can call 311 or 553-0123

- Raiding Trash Cans and Dumping Trash on the Street
- Creating a disturbance - voices or car stereos
- Drug sales or use
- Drinking in public
- Loitering in areas with MPC 25 signs
- Unaccompanied minors out after 10:00pm
- Unsupervised minors endangering themselves and others

If you see a crime in progress or need other emergency services such as fire or medical, call **911**
